- a) What do you mean by Population Structure?

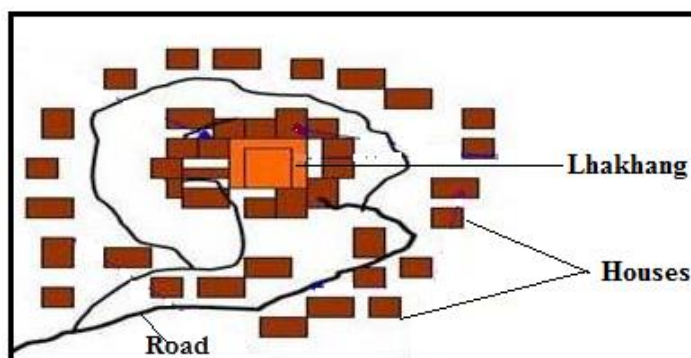

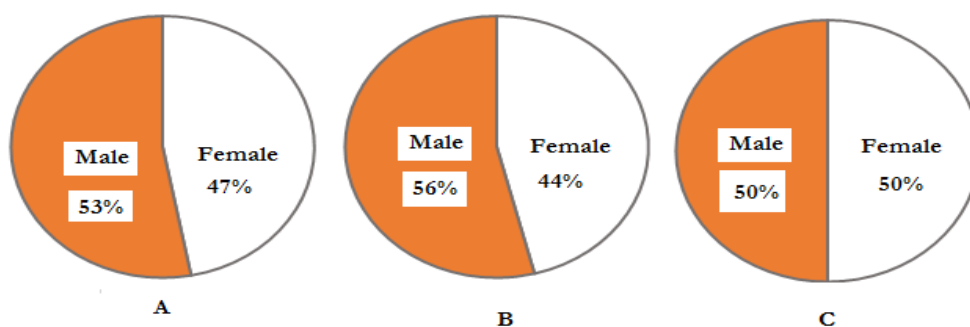
Question 4
