Football

Wangchuk plays football. It is his favorite sport. Sure, the other sports are fun, but there is something interesting about football. It is fast, and some sports are fast, but this is like a race. Maybe that's what he likes best about it: the running. It is like a zigzagging race while kicking a ball and that makes it fun. It can be played casually among friends anywhere that you have a nice stretch of grass.

Football is a 90-minute game split into two 45-minute halves. It usually has 11 players per team, including a goalkeeper. Players are usually broken up into four groups: goalkeepers, defense, midfielders and forwards. Goalkeeper is the only player who can handle the ball with their hands. All other players must only use their feet, along with any part of their legs, chests, or heads.

Wangchuk likes playing as a midfielder. It is a fun position, probably with the most running involved. As a midfielder, he must help move the ball down the field to help his own team score. This means that sometimes he would even take shots on the opponent's goal or set up a play for another one of his teammates. He loves getting assists on scores, because if he plays just right, he knows he could help his team score and win.

Referees watch for tripping, offsides penalties, and breaking of rules, but mostly they like to keep the game moving along smoothly. Breaking of rules usually end with the blow of a whistle and one team or the other gets to take the ball from where the event occurred. Major penalties are rare, so penalty shots are fun to watch.
